SIGLE -> *OpenSIGLE*

(System for Information on Grey Literature in Europe)

- a European database of bibliographic records in grey literature

Produced by 7-15 European member organizations

1980 → 2005

Hosts: STN International and Silverplatter/Ovid

Transfer to an open access environment (DSpace) in 2007

Content: Multidisciplinary

Specific fields and information in each record:

- English title or keywords
- SIGLE classification code
- *Availability statement*

Why change?

- Software and user interface:
 - DSpace platform at its technical limits (indexing,..., upload of GL preprints)
 - Absence of features requested by users (export records)

- Content:
 - Improve information on access to the document
 - Add new records
 - Add links to full text

OpenGrey

System for Information on Grey Literature in Europe, is your **open access** to **700.000 bibliographical references** of grey literature (paper) produced in Europe and allows you to **export records** and **locate the documents**.

Examples of grey (*gray*) literature include technical or **research reports**, **doctoral dissertations**, some **conference papers**, some official publications, and other types of grey literature.

OpenGrey covers Science, Technology, Biomedical Science, Economics, Social Science and Humanities.

The site includes **preprints** from the **GL conferences** ([GreyNet](#) International) in full text.

Abstract : This thesis describes in detail the difficulty in choosing an appropriate distribution strategy, which must respect the trends of modern business and as well as the influence of internationalization, globalization and differentiation of the markets. The change in final customers' purchasing behaviour is another important influence. The factors mentioned above require changes in management systems, changes which include all partners who are involved in the process of meeting customers' expectations and predicting changes in those expectations, business activities included. Because of author's job orientation, the main target of this work is to analyze and compare the theoretical aspects recommended in structuralization of distribution systems; to describe in detail the distribution channels currently in use; to classify the factors and theory influencing the choice of a appropriate distribution strategy; to compare the theoretical approach with practical experience and to propose a distribution strategy for a company oriented towards sales of fast-moving consumer goods with an extensive distribution system. Closely tied to the theoretical chapters are two practical applications: the creation of a new distribution system and the application of a differentiated distribution strategy. The practical part of this dissertation and its conclusions highlight the importance of taking into consideration the variety of distribution channels and the contemporary economic situation. The author has not used real values for financial information as the company, Coty, feels some information to be part of its trade secrets. All financial information linked to Czech and Slovak crowns appearing in the text, charts and tables of this work are adjusted by applying a coefficient recommended by the company. The coefficient is a constant. The use of this constant allows us to follow the logic of the calculations without using the real values. ;

Its holdings form the largest collection of Czech and foreign documents from technology and applied natural sciences as well as associated social sciences. It contains total of 1,2 Mil. volumes of books, journals and newspapers, theses, reports, standards, and trade literature in both printed and electronic forms. Besides its own collection, parts of the Central Library of CTU in Prague and Central Library of ICT holdings are accessible in NTK.

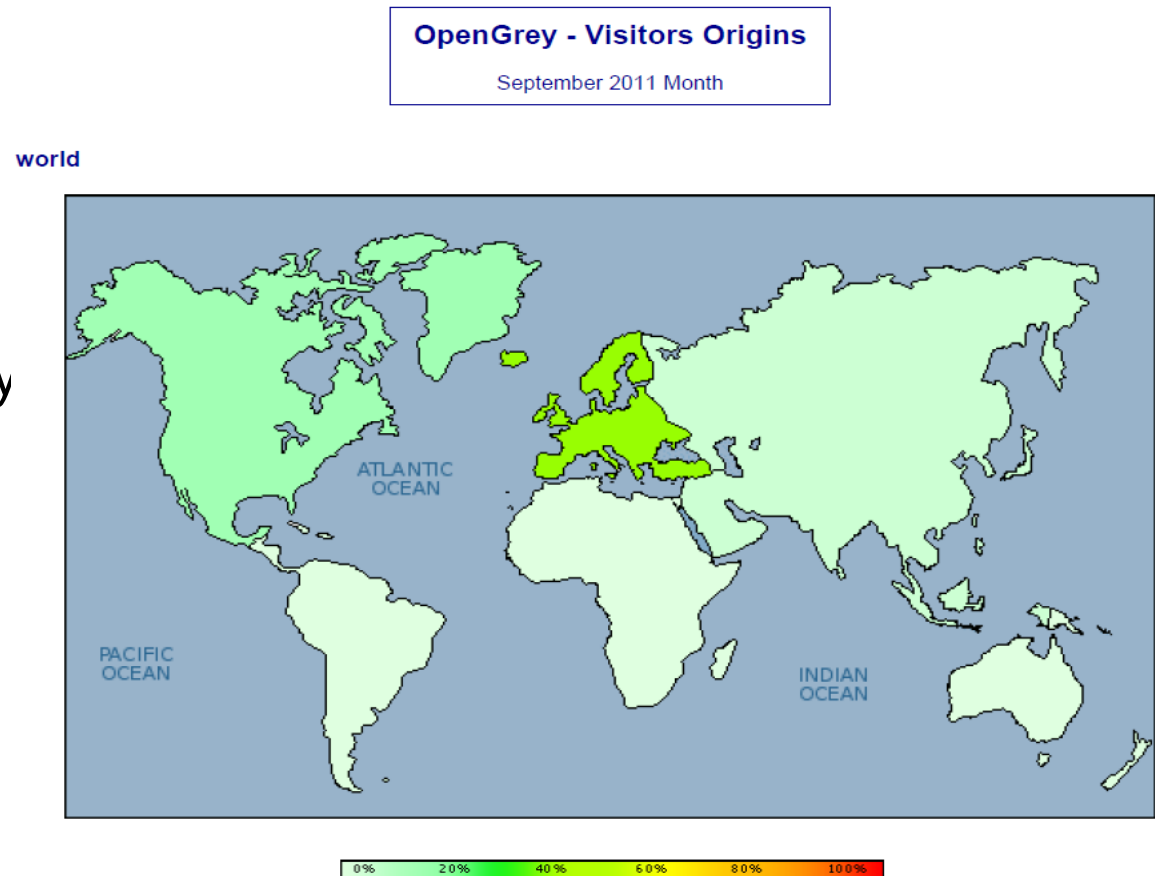
First results on OpenGrey usage



- Statistics tool : Google analytics and an in-house development
- Results comparable to summer 2010
 - 30 000 visits in September 2011 and
 - 70 000 page views (300 000 in 4 months)
- New : access with mobile devices can be monitored (10 visits per day)
- OpenGrey records accessed more than 2 000 000 times in 4 months (based on simple log count for the record handles)

European content for a worldwide audience

- 160 different countries in one month
- United Kingdom, USA and Germany in the lead
- Increasing access from
 - Australia
 - China
 - India



Further developments

- Re-indexing by Google and Google Scholar still ongoing
- OAI-PMH – requests for sets to facilitate harvesting on a subject basis
- Improve record display
- Provide facility to share contents

- Find easy ways to add links to full text for existing records (by bulk update)
- Improve tools and presentations for partners (administration)
